




Welcome




Summer


Winter

Gore Bay and William Purvis Marine Museum



Multiple Ways In and Out

Gore Bay is located on the north side of Manitoulin Island, with direct access to key transportation routes.

Ferry

The Chi-Cheemaun Ferry connects nearby South Baymouth to Tobermory, linking Manitoulin Island to southern Ontario seasonally.

Airport

The Gore Bay-Manitoulin Airport features a newly upgraded \$4.8M terminal with regular private and charter flights, ideal for both personal and business travel.

Highway

Highway 540 and Highway 6 connect Gore Bay to neighbouring towns and off-Island communities, making road travel simple and scenic.

Proximity to Urban Centres

While Gore Bay offers an escape from the city, you're still within a few hours of major hubs:

Sudbury – 2.5 hours away

Sault Ste. Marie – 3.5 hours away

Greater Toronto Area – Reachable by car, ferry, or air, with regular seasonal travel options.

Digital Connectivity

Reliable high-speed internet ensures that even if you're surrounded by nature, you're still fully connected — perfect for remote work, online learning, or running a business from home.






